The grant application timeline has shifted:

• Competitive: April 15 – June 12

• Planning Grants: May 1 – November 15

• Open Submission: May 1 – November 15

• Urgent Need: May 1 – November 15

DHCD has updated CDBG Grant project types:

Competitive Grants now have five primary project types:

1. Economic Development

• Community Economic Development

• Business District Revitalization

• Local & Regional Innovation

2. Comprehensive Community Development

3. Community Service Facilities

4. Public Infrastructure

5. Targeted Neighborhood Housing

Open Submission Grants now have five primary project types:

1. Public Services

2. Construction-Ready Water/Sewer (CRWSF)

3. Regional Water/Wastewater

5. Urgent Need

4. Scattered Site Housing Rehabilitation

Planning Grants categories have been updated:

Activation Planning Grants formerly called "Community Organizing Grants", or "Overall Community Needs Assessment Grants" allow for a locality or an organization on behalf of a locality to partner with DHCD to explore future partnership and project possibilities.

Eligibility A locality is eligible to apply for any CDBG project, granted they meet the eligibility requirements for open contracts: 1) localities are allowed a maximum of two (2) active construction or public service projects at once; and 2) localities are below a \$3 million grant award cap.
